Matrix ECVET:

Will follow the descriptors (knowledge, skills, responsibility, autonomy) defining levels in the EQF. It will present precise guidelines with the profile match in Portugal, Spain and Romania. It will target all VET providers, companies, trainees and national regulatory authorities of qualifications.

Tutorial guide for mobility:

Will consist of a description of the mobility purposes with the main documents used for recognizing the mobility in Europe. It will target all VET providers, trainees, companies, trade unions, sectors associations and other entities that work or help with mobility process.

Network sessions completed!

To undertake the Clothing Technician Profile and Qualification in each partner country, partners worked intensively together.

PT, ES, RO promoted a set of Network sessions with companies and VET providers between June and September 2019. In total it involved 5 Representatives from the national authorities, 22 Representatives of the textile and clothing companies and 33 VET experts.
