Objectives

The WP4 will create a **Training package and implement Train the trainers activities for delivering the Clothing Technician Profile.**

Supports and provides resources to trainers of the textile and clothing sector in order to empower them in delivering this new (re-designed) clothing technician profile and staying updated on the new demands of the T&C companies for the upcoming years;

Develops a training package and implement a training action for trainers.

We are building upon the experience gained within the CoSTUmE implementation.

Innovative training materials are being tailored for the clothing and textile trainers, to become their handfull tool for introducing the CoSTUmE profile to their students.

"Participatory, methodologically solid and pedagogically valid"

These are the incorporated principles of our experts for creating the training package, in accordance to the sectorial realities and needs and under a constant consultation with our target groups.

"Intense testing and implementation hand-in-hand with trainers-practitioners"

A pilot training will allow the evaluation of the new profile/qualification and related resources. This training will ensure a better exploitation of the project results, creating orientations for future use. The participating trainers will have also the possibility to discuss the whole training concept, the scheme and the methodologies defined to undertake the new Clothing Technician Profile.

It will result in a polished, innovative training package and a concerted train-the-trainers for delivering the clothing technician profile and qualification.



Phase1:

PREPARATION

- Encompasses drafting a methodology and the respective tools that will support the design of the training package and the guidelines and orientation to implement the train the trainers.



Phase2:

IMPLEMENTATION

- Structured in two main activities, the first related to the development of the training package and the second to the translation of the contents and resources developed.



Phase3:

VALIDATION

- Dedicated to the train the trainer action. In this phase, we have an active participation of the trainers that will test the training curricula developed. The activities related to recognition involve the developing the orientation to implement the training, the external testing and the guidelines to elaborate the pilot report evaluation
